Dear One Moose Members, As 2020 ends and we move towards the future as One Moose on May 1st we continue our commitment to Mooseheart, Moosehaven, and Moose Charities. As you can imagine, COVID-19 has had a tremendous impact on the Moose Family Center.

Our Lodge closed in early March at the start of this unprecedented shutdown, then our spring fundraising events as well as banquet rentals, and several of our fall events were forced to cancel. This has eliminated a substantial part of our annual revenue.

In response we have now launched the "Bridging the Gap Campaign", a one-time fundraising campaign to help the Lodge weather this crisis. 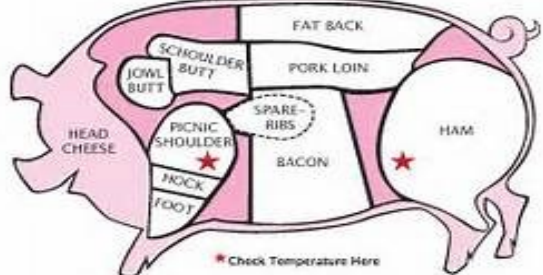
